TIPS FOR SAFE RIDING

- Always be courteous toward other snowmobilers and other outdoor winter activity participants... we can all share the outdoors.
- Knowing the basic laws for your safety can prevent mishaps.
- Always have a lit headlight and taillight so others can see you.
- Highways or road shoulders are illegal to ride on - stay in the ditch or outside bank.
- Drive in the right side ditch after dark.
- Come to a complete stop at all crossings.
- Cross roadways at a 90 degree angle.
- Display license number and decals as required. US Forest Service roads are open for riding unless they are plowed (off-reservation).
- Snowmobiling is not permitted on cross-country ski trails.
- Always carry your registration and identification cards.
- DO NOT DRINK ALCOHOL AND OPERATE A SNOWMOBILE.

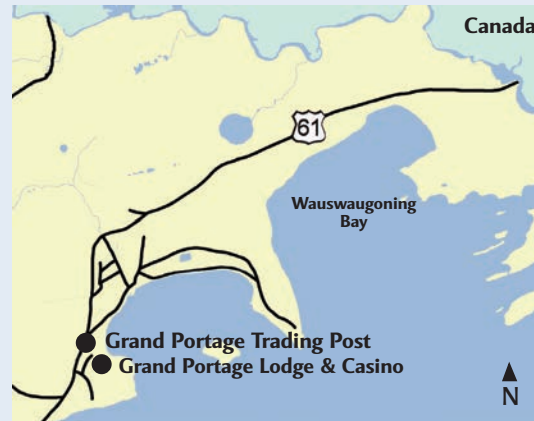
